Techstreet provides full text access to:

- all current Australian Standards
- joint ISO/Australian Standards
- joint NZ/Australian Standards
- current draft Australian Standards
- amendments of Australian Standards
- most Standards Australia handbooks.

The University of South Australia currently holds **four licenses**. This means only four people can access the database at any one time. If you are unable to access the database, please try again later.

Most standards can be read online using the View Online button. Downloaded standards can only be read using the <u>Adobe Acrobat Reader</u> app with the <u>FileOpen</u> plugin. Standards cannot be copied to other devices, and may not be able to be printed.

To access standards via Techstreet, follow these steps:

- 1. Type Techstreet into the Library Collection
- 2. Select the database Techstreet: Standards Australia from the search results
- 3. Navigate to the database via the **Online access** link.

Use the **Search box** to search for a standard number (e.g., AS 1170.0) or to do a keyword search. It will search across titles and descriptions if your keywords don't match a document number or title.



From the Search Results page you can then select your standard. You can also see at a glance the historical versions and amendment history of the standard.





Trying to access an international standard? Techstreet has full text for the Australian equivalent to international standards so try typing in the ISO code in the search box and look for "This Standard is identical with and has been reproduced from...." in **About This Document.**
